

BaconWrapped Medjool Dates

With Red Wine Dipping Sauce

INGREDIENTS

Bacon Wrapped Dates

- 20 dried medjool dates
- 1 cup crumbled blue cheese
- 12 slices smoked bacon
- · 20 small wood skewers/picks

Red Wine Dipping Sauce

- 1 cup burgundy wine
- 3/4 cup granulated Sugar
- 1/4 tsp cinnamon
- 1/4 tsp black pepper

YIELD: 20 DATES

PREP TIME: 15 MINUTES COOK TIME: 20 MINUTES

DIRECTIONS



Par cook bacon for approx. 8-10 minutes at 350F degrees.

Cool and scrape off remaining bacon fat. Cut bacon slices in half and then square off edges.

Remove pit by making a 3/4 inch slit down the side.

Fill date with blue cheese.

Cut date in half width-wise and wrap with bacon, with the cut side facing in so blue cheese doesn't melt out.

Skewer each date and cook in oven for 8-10 minutes at 350F degrees or until the bacon is fully cooked.

Red Wine Dipping Sauce

Combine all ingredients in a sauce pot, set on medium heat and stir frequently. Reduce mix by two thirds until syrup consistency. Strain and cool.

How to Cast From Your Computer to Your TV

To get the most out of your (re)Educate event you should plan on connecting your laptop or phone to your TV.



Direct HDMI Connection

If your laptop or device has a HDMI port you should be able to connect your device directly to the TV via a HDMI cable. Make sure you choose the proper input on your TV and you may need to configure the sound to transmit through the TV. Check here/be/here



AirPlay with Apple

Use AirPlay to stream or share content from your Apple device to your Apple TV or AirPlay 2-compatible smart TV. For detailed instructions please visit the Apple Support page here.



Cast with Google or Android

Use Chromecast to stream or share content from your device to your Chromecast or Chromecast-compatible smart TV. For detailed instructions please visit the Google Chromecast Support page here.

Helpful Tip: Test your device setup a few days before the event to avoid tech issues interrupting your enjoyment of the evening.
